National Networks & State Partners in Louisiana



Louisiana Network Analysis

There are 18 national networks working in Louisiana, supporting 22 state partners. In Louisiana, there are state partners and national networks working on interrelated issues that do not overlap. This could be an advantage or a disadvantage with either deep potential for coalition building in the state or a lack of strong organizations to lead an issue.

State partners with overlap

There are a handful of organizations in Louisiana that have multiple national partnerships:

- Louisiana Budget Project – 3 national networks (EARN, SPP, and Community Catalyst)
- Agenda for Children – 2 national networks (KIDS COUNT and PAC)
- Louisiana Appleseed – 2 national networks (FRAC and Appleseed)
- NOWCRJ (New Orleans Workers' Center for Racial Justice) – 2 national networks (Jobs with Justice and NELP)
- Louisiana Policy Institute for Children – 2 national networks (Alliance for Early Success and Council for a Strong America)

National networks with no overlap

7 national networks (39%) do not have any shared state group partners in the state. They do not overlap with other national networks. They are:

- Center for Popular Democracy
- NAACP
- National Juvenile Justice Network
- National Urban League
- PICO
- Prosperity Now
- SOLVE

National networks with deep connections to the state

7 networks show deeper connections in Louisiana by working with multiple state groups, including:

- Community Catalyst – 3 state groups
- National Juvenile Justice Network – 3 state groups
- FRAC – 3 state groups
- Jobs with Justice – 2 state groups
- SOLVE – 2 state groups
- Council for a Strong America – 2 state groups
- Prosperity Now – 2 state groups
